Hello all,

Winter is finally upon us up here in the North East. We received our first measurable snowfall in early November. In fact, I was able to pull the sleds out and rode around for a few hours on November 7th. That's pretty unbelievable considering last year around this time I remember getting a good sunburn.

Speaking of early winter, we are also having an early ice-fishing season. First and foremost there is no such thing as safe ice. 6+ inches of ice is needed for snowmobiling, but keep in mind just because one section of the lake has 6 inches, doesn't mean the rest of the lake has that ice thickness. It's very important to keep your head on a swivel and always watch your path of travel for dangerous ice conditions.

If any parent is interested in having their child certified in Snowmobile Safety, you can check out the ND Parks and Recreation website under the OHV/Snowmobile tab. Also, if any Club is interested in hosting a class, you can contact Tari Norby with Snowmobile ND at 701-328-5348.

Lastly, don't forget the State Snowmobile Convention will run from the evening of December 15th through the 16th at the Bismarck Ramada. Hope to see you all there.
